



- Shopping








### Getting Around Nagoya

- Walking (a lot)
  - Bring comfortable walking shoes!
  - Physics Office only 3 min away
- Subway
  - 270円 or \$1.80
  - Easy to use IC card like: manaca or suica
  - Add IC card to phone



### Nagoya Subway System

- Looks complicated
- You will master it in 2 weeks!
- Most convenient lines:
  - Purple: Meijo Line
  - Yellow: Higashiyama Line



### Communication

- LINE is the most popular messaging app
- You can download it now!



### How to Pay

- Cash (is king in Japan)
  - Use US debit card at ATM
  - Must pay rent/utilities in cash at convenience store
- Visa/Master card
  - Check the foreign exchange fee!
  - Find credit card with 0% fee
  - Services like Wise
- IC cards
- Code Payments:
  - Line Pay, PayPay, ...
  - Impossible to verify Identity for tourists



#### Cell Phone Service

- Pre-paid SIM/eSIM
  - https://www.sakuramobile.jp/
  - From 3,278 JPY (21.78 USD)
- US Carrier international plan (possibly expensive)
